

# **United Way of Monroe County passes its \$1.3M campaign goal**

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United Way of Monroe County exceeded its \$1.3 million annual campaign goal by \$128.

The campaign, which started in mid-September and wrapped up this spring, earned the nonprofit and its 25 member agencies \$1,300,128.

“The entire community will be better because of the individual donors and workplace leaders who stepped up,” Barry Lessow, executive director of United Way, said in a news release.

Last year, United Way fell short of its \$1,410,000 goal fundraising goal, earning \$1,285,869 between the end of 2014 and beginning of 2015. The 2015 to 2016 total is \$100,000 more than last year’s earnings.
