The organization's three E's — Education, Earnings and Essentials — break down the strategy to help lead people to self-sufficiency.

On education, donations to United Way help improve early childhood literacy and keep older students in school. United Way is a leader of the Monroe Smart Start Birth-to-Five Coalition and provide free Born Learning materials to parents. It co-coordinates the High School Plus Coalition, which is focused on reducing the number of dropouts. It also funds member agencies that support young people in a number of ways, which can only help their academic success.

On earnings, donations to United Way help it participate in a number of initiatives that support financial stability for local residents through helping people file tax returns (and save money); helping people stay in their homes; and providing job counseling.

The essentials include helping people pay for prescription medications or put enough food on the table. Many member agencies are dedicated to providing essentials for all who need help.

Every dollar makes a difference. For instance, a dollar a week could provide breakfast for a child for the entire summer; \$5 a week could provide an at-risk child a backpack filled with food each weekend.

All 24 of the member agencies help people. That's what United Way is all about.

So why is this the easiest day to help United Way with its mission? Because an envelope is being delivered with today's paper, and you mail it back with a donation to provide whatever help you can.
