



Working with Your Local United Way



Identify your local United Way at iuw.org/capitalgrants and directly confirm that it is a member of Indiana United Ways (IUW).*



Go to <u>iuw.org/capitalgrants</u> to review the grant FAQs and grants application guidance for the Initiative.



Complete the eligibility assessment at iuw.org/capitalgrants.



If your organization appears to qualify, contact your local IUW Member United Way to discuss your project further. You must work directly with your local IUW Member United Way to apply for funding.

Not all qualifying organizations and projects will be invited to apply. The range of potential partners, types of projects, and location of projects throughout the state will be considered to ensure equitable distribution of funds.



Along with your local IUW Member United Way partner, determine whether your project qualifies as a Tier 1 or Tier 2 project.

Tier 1 Request

- Obtain the endorsement of your local IUW Member United Way
- Submit Tier 1 application (by invitation only)
- 8 Committee review of application and project
- Contract signing upon approval

Tier 2 Request

- Obtain the endorsement of your local IUW Member United Way
- Submit Tier 2 application (by invitation only)
- R Committee review
- If given conditional approval, sign partnership agreement with local IUW Member United Way
- Complete fundraising and submit project for final Committee review and approval
- 11 Contract signing upon approval

^{*} Projects located in the United Way of Central Indiana service area (Boone, Hamilton, Hancock, Hendricks, Marion, Morgan, and Putnam Counties) do not qualify under the IUW Statewide Capital Projects Initiative. These communities are served through United Way of Central Indiana's (UWCI) Capital Projects Fund, which is open to accredited community organizations.
