The Bloomington Housing Authority will accept online pre-applications for the Housing Choice Voucher Program (Section 8).

The Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) Program provides housing assistance in the form of a rental subsidy payment to private landlords on the behalf of low-income individuals, families, seniors and persons with disabilities for housing units they have chosen in the private rental market.

Program eligibility is based on household size and income. The income limits for the program are as follows, subject to change:

The Bloomington Housing Authority provides payments directly to participating property owners to offset the cost difference between tenant payments and unit rent. HCV Program applicants choose from a variety of housing options ranging from apartments, duplexes and single-family homes. Families with vouchers generally pay between 30 and 40 percent of the annual adjusted gross income for rent. Rent must be reasonable compared with similar unassisted units in the area, and the property must meet HUD's inspection standards established for the program.
